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Section 3 Qualification and Evaluation Criteria

2. Evaluation Criteria, 2.2: “(b) Delivery schedule”. “Prices of Spare Parts”, “Spare Parts and After Sales Service Facilities in Purchaser’s Country”, “Operating and Maintenance Costs”, “Performance and Productivity of the Equipment” are amended to read as:

The Goods covered under this Bidding Document shall be delivered (shipped) within an acceptable range of weeks specified in Section 6: Schedule of Requirements. No credit will be given to earlier deliveries, and Bids offering delivery beyond this

range will be treated as non-responsive. Within this acceptable range, an adjustment per week, as specified in **BDS** 36.2(d), will be added for evaluation to the Bid price of Bids offering deliveries later than the earliest delivery period specified in the Schedule of Requirements.

The price to the Purchaser of establishing the minimum service facilities and parts inventories, as outlined in **BDS** 36.2(c) or elsewhere in the Bidding Document, if quoted separately, shall be added to the Bid price.

Operating and maintenance costs of the goods will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria specified in **BDS** 36.2(d) or in the technical specifications set forth in Section 6: Schedule of Requirements.

Performance

Bidders shall state the guaranteed performance or efficiency in response to the technical specification set forth in Section 6: Schedule of Requirements. For each drop in the performance or efficiency below the norm of 100, an adjustment for an amount specified in **BDS** 36.2(e) will be added to the Bid price, representing the capitalized cost of additional operating costs over the life of the plant, using the methodology specified in the technical specifications set forth in Section 6: Schedule of Requirements.
